## **Federation President's Report**

**January 2020**



2020 promises to be yet another very full year for the TPI Federation and all TPI/SRs and their families. Our thoughts are with all those, and especially TPI/SRs, who have been adversely affected by the disasters of the end of 2019 and now the beginning of 2020. It is not only those TPI/SRs who have been directly affected, but also those who have been psychologically affected by the scenes on TV and social media as a result of what they have seen and heard, day after day, during this crisis.

It is most important that all Veterans, and your families, remember that Open Arms is available to you all should you be finding it hard to cope during these harsh times. Please call 1800 011 046 for the mental health needs of you and your family.

The Partners of Veterans have an information sheet available for all NSW Veterans, War Widows and Partners of Veterans. This is available on the TPI Federation Facebook page. The TPI Federation thanks that Partners of Veterans for collating and sharing this information.

As of 1st January 2020, the PBS and the RPBS Safety Net threshold has been adjusted. From 1 January 2020, you pay up to \$41.00 for most PBS medicines or **\$6.60** if you have a concession card. The amount of co-payment is adjusted on 1 January each year in line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

This will now mean that as of 1st January 2020 there will be a requirement for 48 scripts before the instigation of the Safety Net Threshold. thresholds have been lowered:

- from \$390.00 to **\$316.80** for concessional patients
- from \$1550.70 to \$1486.80 for general patients.

The ADF Member and Family Transition Seminars have been announced for 2020. If you have any family members or friend who are interested in attending a Seminar please contact your local TPI Association for dates and times. All Welfare and Compensation Officers are also welcome to attend.

Consumers can now apply for an aged care assessment online. A new online form is available on the My Aged Care website that allows consumers or someone acting on their behalf to:

- register with My Aged Care
- apply for their first assessment online.

The form can be completed in your own time as an alternative to calling the My Aged Care contact centre. Visit the My Aged Care website for information about how consumers can now apply for an assessment at <https://www.myagedcare.gov.au/assessment>.

The TPI Federation has, again, written to the Prime Minister with regard to the on-going campaign for a fair and equitable economic loss compensation. It has been estimated by DVA that approximately 50,000 DVA Veterans and War Widows have been affected by the recent disasters. It is estimated that at least 10% of these are TPI/SRs.

For these Veterans to still only receive 61.9% of the tax-adjusted Minimum Wage for their inability to ever work again, and now on top of the potential to have to rebuild their lives without any appropriate compensation is most disappointing. The almost 7-year campaign to gain justice for our TPI/SRs needs to be addressed by the Prime Minister now. These Veterans need to have a more correct compensation so that it is more reflective of a 'living wage'.

Finally, I revisit the hearing aid issue. Just prior to Christmas, following a meeting with the DVA Secretary, Liz Cosson AM CSC, it was announced that the Secretary will hold a DVA Secretary's Hearing Aid Round Table in the early part of 2020. This has now been scheduled to be held in early February – as the DVA Secretary had promised in December. Representatives from a number of ESOs, Department of Health, Hearing Aid Providers and Veterans will be invited to attend. A report on this meeting will be provided in the next issue of this magazine.

Please pass this along to your Veteran and War Widow friends and families. They must know that they – NEVER, NEVER, EVER – pay for their hearing aids.

If there are any problems with obtaining fully subsidised hearing aids please contact me.

# TREATMENT FOR CLINICAL CONDITIONS

## Funding for pharmaceuticals and health services in the home

The Repatriation Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (RPBS) provides eligible veterans, war widow(er)s, and their dependants access to a wide range of pharmaceuticals and dressings at a concessional rate. The RPBS also includes access to all items listed in the Schedule of Pharmaceutical Benefits available to the general community.

If you are a Gold Card or White Card holder living at home, you may also be eligible for a referral for health services such as community nursing and delivered through the Veterans' Home Care (VHC) program. You may also be entitled to assistance through the Rehabilitation Appliances Program (RAP) to help you maintain functional independence in your home.

The Coordinated Veterans' Care (CVC) Program is available to Gold Card holders who are living at home and are at risk of being admitted to hospital due to congestive heart failure, coronary artery disease, pneumonia, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, diabetes or as a result of other complex care needs.

It is important to note that restrictions may apply to some services. You can find more about the DVA funded health services available to you and their associated restrictions.

## What type of health services are not funded by DVA?

DVA does **not** fund alternative therapies which include:

- acupuncture and acupressure\*
- aromatherapy
- art therapy
- equine therapy
- homeopathy
- hypnotherapy and hypnosis
- massage or therapeutic touch\*
- meditation
- music therapy
- reflexology and relation therapy
- reiki
- tai chi
- yoga

\*Note: Massage services **may** be funded when provided by a Medicare Australia registered physiotherapist, chiropractor or osteopath as part of a treatment plan (upon referral by a GP). Acupuncture can only be funded when delivered by a GP registered with Medicare Australia to deliver that service.

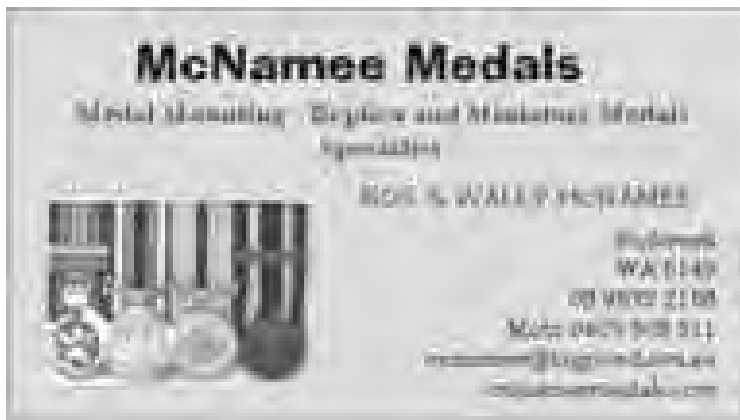

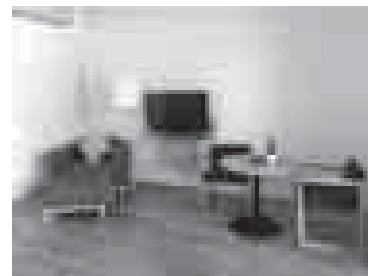

ROYAL New Zealand Air Force (RNZAF) NH90 helicopters and their crews have provided sterling service in Australia, lifting their fair share of the load in the battle against the bushfires.

In the skies over Canberra, the NH90s of RNZAF's 3 Sqn could be seen delivering air mobile response teams from 7RAR to bush clearings in the surrounding native forests, where the soldiers were clearing access tracks and helicopter landing points for the ACT's Emergency Services Agency.

The helicopters proved ideal for the task, capable of carrying 12 passengers or a mixture of personnel and equipment.

The helicopters also winched soldiers and their chainsaws into overgrown landing points for clearance operations.

For 3 Sqn pilot Flt-Lt Loic Ifrah, the opportunity to serve in Australia was an honour.

"It's great to help out our partners across the Tasman," Flt-Lt Ifrah said.

The unfortunate circumstances of the aviator's deployment brought extremely challenging flying situations where everyone's skills have been taxed to the limit.

"We've had conditions where visibility has been reduced to almost nothing," he said.

"They're conditions we haven't experienced in New Zealand."

Cpl Bruce Cane, a 3 Sqn helicopter loadmaster, has seen plenty of Australian countryside from the open side door of the NH90s as they criss-crossed over south-east NSW.

Cpl Cane transferred from the Territorial Army to the Air Force in 2017, and his initial ideas about life as an aircrewman have been surpassed. "It's been everything and more," Cpl Cane said.

"I wasn't sure about what I would get out of it, but the people I am surrounded by, the jobs I've been able to go away and do, and the people I have been able to help have made it incredibly fulfilling."

Cpl Cane was notified on a Saturday afternoon that he was needed for overseas service, and on the Monday he was on his way to HMAS Albatross at Nowra on the NSW south coast.

He said the events that unfolded from then were very powerful.

"The level of devastation south of Nowra was quite intense," he said.

"I know we are definitely doing what we can – delivering fuel and fodder to isolated communities.

"We've also been taking 7RAR infantry into the forests to create firebreaks outside of Canberra.

"For me, the biggest thing has been meeting the people. In times like these it's really great to see the communities come together."

Three RNZAF multi-role helicopters began arriving in Australia on January 7.

5. The new model wheelchair is made at \$100
6. The ring-pull of either ring-pulls or cans will enter the cost of a wheelchair.
7. 10,000 ring-pulls are needed to make the 100 kilograms
8. 12,000 aluminium cans are needed to make the 100 kilograms.

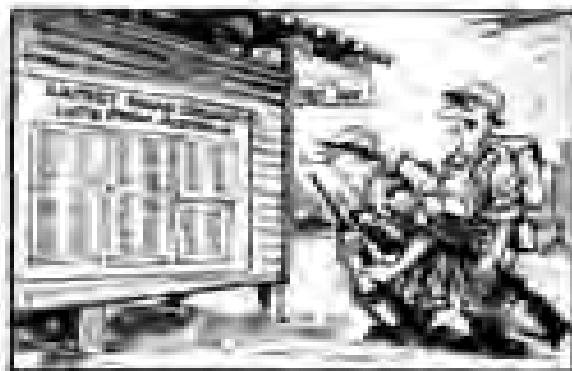

### DVA's Online Services Continue to Grow

Over 14,000 Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) clients have registered to use DVA's online service, MyAccount, and the number continues to grow. With the release of new services in May, even more choice and convenience is available to DVA clients who elect to go online.

From May, DVA MyAccount members are now able to view additional personal information, including DVA recorded details of income and assets, as well as details of payments made to them under the Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1988 (SRCA), and any DVA-accepted medical conditions under SRCA.

For MyAccount users who travel overseas, a new online facility to advise DVA of travel dates will be available.

Significantly, for both DVA clients who are MyAccount users, and for the wider veteran and ex-service community, a new online facility will present the three existing claims for initial liability (VEA, SRCA and MRCA) and made the fully electronic. This initiative gives claimants an online process for selecting the desired form, completing the required details, uploading supporting documentation, and provides claimants with a claim reference number.

"Lodging a claim form online provides convenience to existing and prospective DVA clients" a DVA spokesperson said, "and the in-built guidance that supports online entry of claim details makes it easier to ensure that all relevant information can be provided."

As always, the services available online through MyAccount will not replace traditional means of communicating with DVA. You can still contact DVA by phone, fax, email, mail and face-to-face.

Veterans' Home Care is a DVA program that helps veterans and war widow and widowers with assessed low care needs to remain living in their own homes. It provides a range of home support services including: **Domestic Assistance** - assistance with essential tasks which the eligible person is unable to carry out. **Personal Care** - assistance with daily self-care tasks such as eating, bathing, toileting and dressing. A Community Nursing assessment may be required for those needing higher levels of care.

**Home and Garden Maintenance** - tasks such as replacing light bulbs, but not including major home repairs, tree felling, or routine cosmetic or ornamental gardening services unless there is a safety hazard. and **Respite Care** (in home and emergency respite and approved residential respite) - temporary relief provided to the carer of a veteran or war widow or widower or a veteran or war widow or widower who is a carer.

To be eligible for a Veterans' Home Care assessment a person must be:

- a veteran of the Australian defence forces; or
- an Australian mariner; or
- a defence or war widow or widower of a veteran of the Australian defence forces or an Australian mariner, and have,
- a Repatriation Health Card - for all conditions (Gold Card); or
- a Repatriation Health Care - for specific conditions (White Card).



## YOUR WILL

### Marriage of Testator / Testatrix

If you marry after you have made a Will, your marriage will have the effect of cancelling your Will unless

- a special section has been put in it, or
- for the will of a person who dies on or after 9 February 2008, there is other evidence to show the Will was made when you were contemplating marriage.

This could result in a legal argument over your estate that could end up in the courts.

If, when you make your Will, you are about to get married, you should include a statement that says you wrote your Will "in contemplation of marriage", and you should name the person you intend to marry. If you then marry that person, your Will is not cancelled.

People who have married after making their Will should get advice from a lawyer to find out if the Will is valid and should consider making a new Will to include the changed situation.

### Divorce of testator / testatrix

If you get divorced or your marriage is annulled on or after 9 February 2008 your Will is cancelled unless

- a contrary intention is expressed in your Will or
- there is other evidence showing this intention.

So if you do not want your Will cancelled when you get divorced you should state this in your Will. If you then get divorced your Will is not revoked.

If you were divorced before 9 February 2008 your Will is not cancelled when you divorce. You may want to consider making a new will to include the new situation.

### Social Planning For Retirement

The average Australian will spend approximately 20 years, one quarter of their life, retired. Research reveals that many have not planned financially and that fewer have planned how they will spend their time. Google 'Retirement Planning' and you will find dozens of sites suggesting ways to financially prepare for your post-employment decades, but few providing a framework for social planning.

Time with the children/grandchildren is often the notion, but they too move on. A British study determined that strong social networks led to more satisfying retirement than having children or grandchildren around. Those in a long-term relationship were also more satisfied than single retirees. The message for retirement planning? For most people, ensuring community participation is important in lieu of work, and it is probably a good idea to involve your partner in your planning to ensure s/he is happy to have you around!

Social planning for retirement mirrors financial planning: Set and prioritise goals, determine a path to get there, minimise risks and maximise returns. Some will have more control over their decisions than others, but a satisfying retirement won't just 'happen'. Consider:

What is your perception of retirement? If it is simply to sit on the couch watching TV, it is likely to be a shorter retirement. Or more likely, do you see an opportunity?

Are there aspects of work that you will miss, including income? Do you want to retire abruptly, or transition gradually through part-time, job-share or casual work? You may not have (or want) to give up all contact. Is there a social group at work (or alumni) to maintain relationships? Until you have a clear plan of how you will spend your time, it can be difficult to determine what your financial needs will be.

Who is the 'new' you, and what do you want to be (like when you left school, but with decades of wisdom to guide)? What attributes, experiences and strengths do you have? Write them down. Identify your weaknesses honestly and how you might address them or minimise their impact.

Set your goals in realistic and achievable terms, but don't be afraid to extend yourself and take a risk. Will you be very different socially? Has the inner musician, student, artist, walker, traveller, actor, genealogist, gardener, entrepreneur, business owner or volunteer been trapped in the workplace? Plan ahead if you can envision this and structure your transition to maximise the chance of success.

Will you miss the structure of the working day? If yes, maintain a clear routine, and even a 'working' week. If not, enjoy the flexibility and consider how you will achieve your goals with a little less certainty. You may have an extra 50 hours available each week - use them well.

Many retirees 'downsize' or opt for a sea/tree change. There are social losses that occur with such a decision, as friends and neighbours are further away. Some find value in renting and/or joining social groups in their chosen area ahead of the move in order to better inform their decision.

The MHPE messages of physical activity, sound nutrition, social engagement and mental stimulation become even more important.

What does your spouse/partner think about your retirement plans? Will you get underfoot or complement each other? This is the most important discussion of all.

If you choose to pass on something to the children following such planning, regardless of the inheritance, it will be a happy, stimulated and engaged retiree who the grandchildren will always remember as someone they wanted to be with.

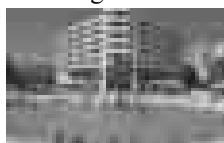

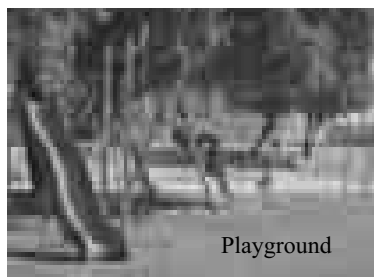

Mandy and Rick Grosvenor own and run a certified biodynamic (chemical free) fruit farm at Kangaroo Lake which is between Kerang and Swan Hill in north west Victoria. They have available a self-contained cabin that they would like to offer respite accommodation to Returned Service personnel who may need somewhere restful to recover for a variety of reasons.

The farm is 47 acres in size and being right beside the lake is a very peaceful place to be, with extensive walking tracks, and is a popular fishing spot.

The cabin measures approx. 8m x 5m; has its own bathroom, kitchen, queen size bed & soon to be installed 2 bunk beds, air conditioning, heating, and driveway. It's completely lockable, safe and private. It does have 2 steps (with handrails), but once inside is completely level.

They are not used every day, only when the bird population tries to consume the farm's income. They nickname them sharefarmers.

There is no cost to rent the cabin only a contribution of \$10 per week towards the electricity bill.

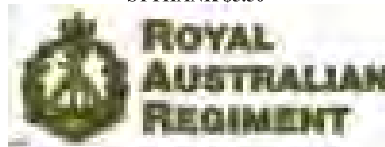

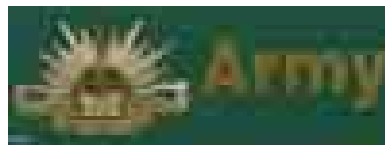

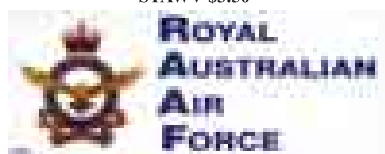
